Track Description

In almost all production systems, the issues of production scheduling and preventive maintenance planning involve clearly inter-connected decisions for which some trade-off must be found. However, a large majority of articles in the relevant research literature treats these planning issues as if the involved decisions are independent and unrelated. Only few articles raised and discussed the question of integrating production scheduling and preventive maintenance planning decisions. Even in practice these interrelated decisions are sometimes dealt with in an independent way. Therefore, the aim of this track is to present the state of the art in this area, and present new approaches, models and methods for integrated production and maintenance decisions.

Recommended Topics

This track is open to any contribution on integrated production and maintenance planning at all levels of the decision-making process (Strategic level, tactical level and operational level). Researchers as well as practitioners are invited to submit complete original papers or propose special sessions in line with the topics of this special track.

Authors are requested to provide a full paper of 10 pages maximum, written in English. The full manuscript should be submitted in accordance with the template format of the conference (available at <https://symposia.cirrelt.ca/IESM09/en/Instructionstoauthors>)
