The new policies must take account jointly of factors such as the degradation of the production facilities according to the production rate, the constraints due to the maintenance and production plans interrelations, ...

We hope new investigation results to shed a new light on the interactions between production and maintenance and bring more global support to industrial managers for greater effectiveness of production.
