The CIRRELT (Interuniversity Research Centre on Enterprise Networks, Logistics and Transportation), jointly with the Faculty of Arts and Sciences of the Université de Montréal, offers a course of three (3) credits to which any master or doctoral student can register to upon approval from their institution.
